I agree to comply with directives and specifications that may be established by the Secretary for the purpose of assuring the safe production (Section 9206) of blood or blood component products. The Secretary may immediately suspend the production or shipment of any blood or blood component product that is deemed to constitute an immediate hazard, pending resolution as prescribed by the California Code of Regulations.
