APPLICATION FOR ANNUAL OUT-OF-STATE PERMIT - 50-MILE

Pursuant to Section 21067, Division 10 of the California Food and Agricultural Code:

- (a) The Chief may issue an annual permit to allow cattle to be transported out of this state without the brand inspection required pursuant to this article under all of the following conditions:
 - 1. The cattle are transported for pasture purpose.
 - 2. The cattle are transported a distance of not more than 50 miles from the point of origin to point of destination.
 - 3. There is no change of ownership of the cattle.
- (b) The department may charge a fee to cover its cost in issuing and renewing the annual permit. The fee may not exceed one hundred dollars (\$100.00).
- (c) The Chief may, at any time, revoke a permit and require a brand inspection if he or she determines that this action is necessary to enforce this division.
