K1	Methods used to clean and maintain public-use facilities, grounds, and buildings.
K2	Tools to clean and maintain public-use facilities, grounds, and buildings.
K3	Operating tools and equipment such as lawn mowers, leaf blowers, hand tools, forklifts, water trucks, dump trucks, and tractors.
S1	Operate a variety of tools and equipment (e.g., lawn mower, trimmers, blowers, vacuum sweepers, and floor scrubbers).
S2	Drive lightweight trucks, tractors, dump trucks, and forklifts to perform a variety of tasks, e.g., pick-up leaves and move tables, chairs, bleachers, etc.
A1	Understand and follow work directions.
A2	Work cooperatively with others.
A3	Learn safe physical work procedures.
A4	Perform manual tasks.
A5	Communicate effectively in a professional manner with others (e.g., co-workers, supervisor, and the public) to learn and perform assigned tasks.
A6	Read effectively to learn and perform assigned tasks.
A7	Write effectively to learn and perform assigned tasks.
A8	Perform basic arithmetic to measure chemicals, order supplies, measure to build walls, frame concrete slabs, etc.
A9	Maintain cooperative relations with supervisor, co-workers, and the general public in the course of work.
A11	Read, understand, and implement directions and contracts according to event set up.
A12	Drive on and off the fairgrounds to haul materials and debris, parts, supplies, and equipment.
