A04	Ability to operate a variety of tools and equipment (e.g., sander, band saw, airless sprayer, rototiller, forklift) in performing all duties in maintaining the grounds, and buildings.
A05	Ability to lead a crew of fair workers by providing verbal directions/instructions to carry out maintenance assignments, including setting up/tearing down for annual fair and interim events of a District Agricultural Association (DAA).
PC01	Willingness to work irregular hours or odd shifts on occasion such as evenings and weekends.
