## Asian Citrus Psyllid Quarantine Program Nursery Treatment Information

Production nurseries located in Asian citrus psyllid (ACP) Nursery Regional Quarantine Zones 2 or 3 with ACP <a href="https://host.plants">host.plants</a> offered for intrastate sale or distribution are required to operate under a compliance agreement with the California Department of Food and Agriculture (CDFA). An establishment is classified as a production nursery if it produces plants. Wholesale nurseries that upsize any nursery stock, including non-ACP host plants, are also classified as a production nursery. If your establishment does not currently have a compliance agreement with CDFA's ACP Program, please call (916) 274-6300 or email at <a href="mailto:ACPCompliance@cdfa.ca.gov">ACPCompliance@cdfa.ca.gov</a> to obtain an agreement.

Production nurseries are required to treat all ACP host plants available for sale or distribution on a 90-day cycle. ACP host plants, not grown and maintained in an APHIS approved exclusionary facility, are only eligible to be moved within the nursery regional quarantine zone within 90 days of the approved treatment. The approved treatment shall consist of both a systemic and foliar application with Program approved products. The list of Program approved products may be found here:

All regulatory treatments must be confirmed or witnessed by a Program official. It is incumbent upon the user to follow all label directions when using any of the approved products for quarantine certification processes.

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
