

Asian Citrus Psyllid-Free Declaration Form

For Bulk Citrus Leaving the Asian Citrus Psyllid Quarantine Zones

Bulk citrus fruit is prohibited from moving from Asian Citrus Psyllid (ACP) Bulk Citrus Regional Quarantine Zones 2, 3, 4, 5, 6 & 7. CDFA has issued a special permit (authority CCR 3154) to allow the movement of bulk citrus from the above ACP bulk citrus regional quarantine zones if free of ACP. All shipments of bulk fruit leaving the ACP bulk citrus regional quarantine zones must be accompanied by this completed ACP-Free Declaration Form. **A copy of the ACP-Free Declaration Form must be submitted to the local County Agricultural Commissioner's (CAC) office at least 72 hours in advance of harvest and must be provided to the receiving packer or processor upon delivery. The receiving CAC must also be notified at least 24 hours in advance of shipment.**
