


# Equine - Official Identification Options

### **Description**



A complete description identifying the individual equine, including, but not limited to: name, age, breed, color, sex, distinctive markings, and unique permanent forms of identification (e.g. brands, tattoos, scars, cowlicks, blemishes)

## **Registration Tattoos**



Should be recorded and included as part of the description of the equine. The equine must be accompanied by registration papers.

## **Digital Photograph**

Digital photos sufficient enough to identify the equine, usually taken of both sides and face of the equine. They can be used on electronic forms.

## **Microchip**





USDA compliant 134.2 kHz (ISO 11784/11785) microchips placed into the nuchal ligament in the middle third of the neck on the left side on the equine.

Non-ISO electronic identification injected to the equine on or before March 11, 2014.
