Plaintiffs, THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA, by and through it attorneys PHILLIP J. CLINE, District Attorney for the County of Tulare, by RICHARD B. ISHAM, Deputy District Attorney, having filed their Complaint herein against defendants PARK BILLING, CO., INC., a corporation, sued herein as PARK BILLING, INC., a corporation, and RANCHO FIESTA MOBILE ESTATES, also known as RANCHO FIESTA MOBILHOME PARK, said Defendants having stipulated and consented to this Stipulated Final Judgment and Injunction (hereinafter referred to as "Final Judgment") prior to the taking of any evidence and without this judgment constituting

evidence of any admissions by any Defendants regarding any issue of law or fact alleged in the Complaint; and

The court having considered the pleadings and the stipulation of the parties, and Good Cause appearing therefore IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED THAT:

- 1. This Court has jurisdiction over the subject matter of the Complaint and over the parties hereto.
- 2. Pursuant to sec. 527 of the Code of Civ. Proc., sec. 17203 of the Bus. & Prof. Code and the Court's inherent equity powers, Defendant PARK BILLING, CO., INC., their successors, assigns and all persons, corporations or other entities acting under, by, through or on behalf thereof, or acting in concert or participation with or for defendants, be permanently restrained and enjoined from:
  - (a) Providing bills in which a "no read" is indicated by the meter reader and no usage is applied one month followed by a large usage the following month, resulting in an inappropriately applied baseline allowance over a 30-day period as opposed to a 60-day period.
  - (b) Violating the laws of the State of California, including: Bus. & Prof. Code secs. 12024, 12024.1, 12024.2, 12026 and 12107, Cal. Code of Reg., Title 4, Div. 9, Ch. 1, secs. 3.33, UR.2.2 and Ch.5, sec. 4090.
- (c) Engaging in any unfair business practice as defined in Bus. & Prof. Code sec. 17200.

 (d) Plaintiff shall not initiate enforcement proceedings of the injunctive measures herein with respect to defendant PARK BILLING, CO., INC., their successors, assigns and all persons, corporations or other entities acting under, by, through or on behalf thereof, or acting in concert or participating with or for defendants, until such time as there exist unresolved issues referenced in any Notice of Violation(s), as to matters in contention arising after January 1, 2009, issued by any duly authorized governmental agency with respect to billing practices of said defendant of its submetered tenants.

- 3. Pursuant to sec. 527 of the Code of Civ. Proc., sec. 17203 of the Bus. & Prof. Code and the Court's inherent equity powers, Defendant FIESTA MOBILE ESTATES, their successors, assigns and all persons, corporations or other entities acting under, by, through or on behalf thereof, or acting in concert or participation with or for defendants, be permanently restrained and enjoined from:
- (a) Unlawfully billing submetered tenants of the RANCHO FIESTA MOBILE ESTATES for utility charges from any public utility supplying utilities services to said mobile home park and its tenants and providing incorrect information to any company providing billing services for the submetered tenants of the RANCHO FIESTA MOBILE ESTATES;
- (b) Violating submetering laws of the State of California, including: Bus. & Prof. Code secs. 12024, 12024.1,

 12024.2. 12026 and 12107, Civil Code secs. 798.38(a) and 798.43.1 subs. (a), (b) and (c); Pub. Util. Code sec. 739.5 subs. (a) and (e); Cal. Code of Reg., Title 4, Div. 9, Ch. 1, secs. 3.33, UR.2.2 and Ch. 5, sec. 4090, and So. Calif. Ed. Rule No. 18, E.3, G and Sch. DMS-2, Spec. Cond. 6.a and So. Calif. Gas Co. Rule No. 24 B.2(a) to 8-11-05, Rule No. 24B.1.d.2(a) from 8-11-05 and sch. GS/GSL, Spec. Cond. 2.

- (c) Engaging in any unfair business practice as defined in Bus. & Prof. Code sec. 17200, as such practices pertain to the actions and laws referenced in Paragraphs 3(a) and 3 (b) herein.
- (d) Plaintiff shall not initiate enforcement proceedings of the injunctive measures herein with respect to defendant FIESTA MOBILE ESTATES (their successors, assigns and all persons, corporations or other entities acting under, by, through or on behalf thereof, or acting in concert or participating with or for defendants) until such time as there exist unresolved issues referenced in any Notice of Violation(s), as to matters in contention arising after January 1, 2009, issued by any duly authorized governmental agency with respect to billing practices of said defendant of its submetered tenants.
- 4. The injunctive provisions set forth in this Final Judgment shall become effective January 1, 2009, after which they shall expire on December 31, 2011.
