






Requesting a Movement Permit

How to Move Safely in a Control Area

General Information

 Quarantined premises should request a permit for any movement on or off the premises.

How does a Premises become Quarantined

The Incident Management Team (IMT) will decide which premises are quarantined during an incident. In most cases, premises are quarantined if they fall within a Control Area or are connected to another quarantined premises through business practices.

Contacting

A representative of the quarantined premises requests the movement permit from the IMT permitting unit:

- In-state permits need to be requested 48 hours before movement is expected so the requested movement may be assessed properly
- Out-of-state permits need to be requested at least 72 hours before expected movement

Information Needed

- Origin and destination premises (name and address)
- Contact information for both premises (name, phone number, email, hauler/shipper)
- Items or animals being moved (e.g., manure, feed, eggs, cows, associated IDs if applicable)
- Quantity (e.g., 50 cows, 5 loads of feed)
- Expected date(s) of movement
- Frequency of movement (e.g., one-time, 3 times a week)

Approved Permits

- Once approved, the permit will be emailed within 1-3 days to the requester and case manager if applicable
- A physical copy of the permit must be held by the origin and destination as well as the hauler during movements

Remember

- Movements without approval or permit are a violation of your quarantine and may result in Notice of Violations and fines
- Permit eligibility is a risk-based determination by IMT and requires activation and auditing of an enhanced biosecurity plan
- A movement permit may be revoked or not renewed if the operation does not comply with all permit and biosecurity requirements
- The quarantined premises is legally responsible for ensuring that all movements onto or off of the premises occur according to the conditions of the permit and that all businesses associated with movements on to or off of the premises comply with the permit conditions
