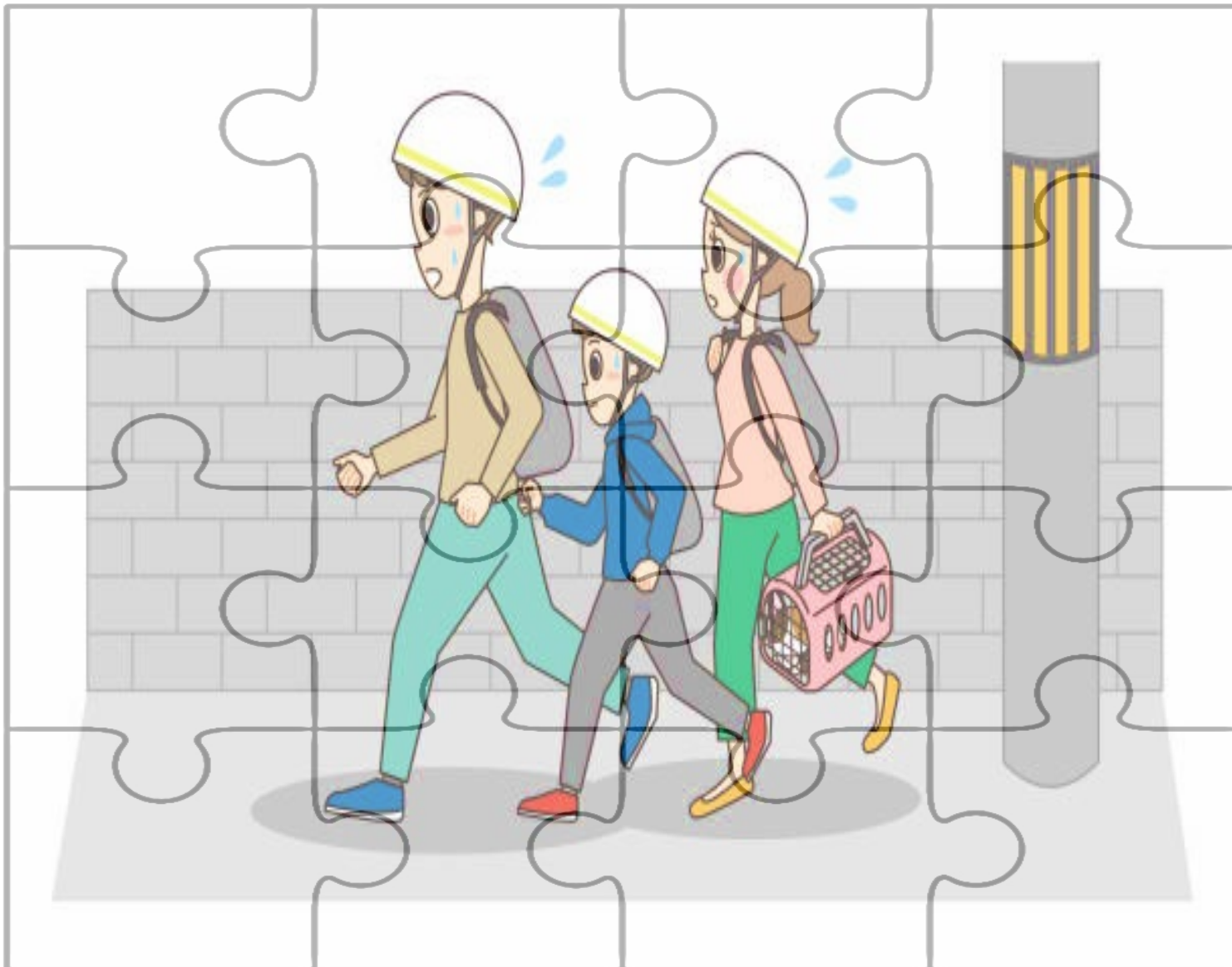


Evacuation Puzzle

Put the puzzle pieces together to show what to do when you are told to evacuate to a safer place because of a wildfire, flood, earthquake or other natural disaster. Take your "Go Bags" with you and put your pet in a carrier to keep it safe. Remember that if it is not safe for your family to stay home, it isn't safe for your pets.



Instructions:

“DO NOT” CUT THE PUZZLE PIECES YOURSELF. YOUR PARENTS NEED TO HELP YOU DO THE FOLLOWING BEFORE YOU CAN START TO PUT YOUR PUZZLE TOGETHER.

Cricut Machine or Puzzle Maker Machine Cutter

- **Print** your picture onto sticker or contact paper and attach it to the chipboard.
- **Secure** the chipboard to a strong cutting mat and load it into the machine.
- **Cut** the puzzle using the appropriate blade and settings.

By Hand

For a more hands-on approach, you can create a puzzle yourself using simple tools.

- **Print** your picture onto sticker or contact paper and attach it to the chipboard.
- **Secure** the chipboard to a strong cutting mat.
- **Cut** the pieces carefully using a sharp knife to cut along your traced lines. A ruler can help with straight cuts but be mindful of the irregular puzzle shapes.
- **Finish the puzzle:** Scramble the pieces and you're ready to start building your unique creation.
