Subject: Interstate Entry Permit Requirements for Cattle Entering California

Effective April 1, 2017, in accordance with Division 2 of Title 3 of the California Code of Regulations, an Interstate Livestock Entry Permit is required for **all cattle** entering California regardless of sex and age.

Exceptions:

- Cattle moving on a Pasture to Pasture permit.
- Cattle moving directly from one location in California through another state and back to a second location in California, or moving through California with no offloading.

Interstate Livestock Entry Permits are valid for fifteen (15) days and can be obtained by calling (916) 900-5052. Please dial that number if you have any questions regarding animal movement.
