The People of the State of California to:

Rob Bonta in his official capacity as the Attorney General of the State of California
Anne Marie Schubert in her official capacity as the District Attorney of the County of
Sacramento, and as representative of all district attorneys statewide

The petition for writ of mandate on file herein having been considered, and this Court having
ordered that a writ of mandate issue,

WE DO COMMAND that you are hereby enjoined from enforcing the prohibition on intrastate
sales of whole pork meat (whether originating within or outside California) pursuant to Health and
Safety Code Sections 25990(b)(2) and 25991(e)(3) until 180 days after final regulations are enacted by
the California Department of Food and Agriculture and the California Department of Public Health
pursuant to Health and Safety Code Section 25993(a).
