



HAULER PROTOCOLS 💂

Arrival Protocol:

- 1. Haulers will stop outside the gate and telephone the office to announce their arrival, so that an employee can be sent to meet them.
- 2. Haulers will accurately complete the Visitor Log, including their Product Movement Permit number. *
- 3. Haulers will don company PPE from the PPE dispensary by the entrance gate.
- 4. A company employee will verify the PMP* and completion of biosecurity procedures.
- 5. Vehicle C&D will occur as the vehicle crosses the perimeter.

*Incoming loads that are not accompanied by a verifiable Product Movement Permit are not allowed to enter the premises.

Protocol for Haulers inside the Perimeter:

- 1. Haulers will be instructed to remain in the cab of their trucks whenever possible while on-site (inside the premises perimeter.)
- 2. If a hauler must exit the cab, disposable PPE will be used, which must include at minimum boot covers and a disposable coverall.
- 3. Vehicle windows will be kept closed whenever possible.
- 4. Loading and unloading of animals/animal products within the perimeter is to be completed by premises personnel whenever possible.

Exit Protocol:

- 1. All vehicles will undergo C&D at the vehicle wash station as they exit the premises gate.
- 2. Haulers will discard all used disposable PPE in the PPE receptacle provided at the gate.

General Hauler Protocols:

- 1. Animal pick-ups and deliveries will be single farm only.
- 2. All empty animal transport vehicles must be cleaned and disinfected prior to arrival at the premises for outgoing loads of poultry or eggs.
- 3. Vehicles delivering poultry to the premises (incoming loads) must be C&D prior to loading.
- 4. A commercial truck wash may be utilized when full vehicle C&D is necessary, including live bird transport racks/modules. Provide the name and address of any commercial truck wash used.
