

## June 17 Workshop and July 1 Hearing Traffic Warning

The following is an FYI regarding the construction that will occur on Interstate 5 around Sacramento this summer. The construction is scheduled during the months of June and July so this could affect your travels to and from the workshop and the hearing. The project will affect I-5 between R Street and Richards Boulevard.

If you are coming **to downtown Sacramento from the North, the closure will directly affect your travel for the workshop on June 17**. I-5 will be entirely closed to southbound traffic between J St and Q St, Friday, June 13th to Monday, June 23rd.

If you are coming to **downtown Sacramento from the South, the closure will directly affect your travel for the hearing on July 1**. I-5 will be entirely closed to northbound traffic between US-50 and I St. Thursday, June 26th to Thursday, July 3rd.

### Alternative routes:

If you are coming from the airport, you can take I-5 South to the I-80 West turn off through West Sacramento, then take US-50 East turnoff into downtown.

If you are coming from the south, plan to exit before the downtown area.

### Notes:

During Northbound I-5 Closures, the Q Street off-ramp into Downtown will be open when northbound through lanes are closed. L & I Street on-ramps will also be open during Northbound closures.

During Southbound I-5 Closures, Richards Blvd. and J Street exits into Downtown will be open (Richards Blvd. now connects with 7th Street into Downtown). P Street on-ramp to US 50 and southbound I-5 will also be open on weekdays.

Please **plan extra time** for travel or consider arriving the night before as CalTrans expects **significant traffic delays**. You can also find more information at [www.fixi5.com](http://www.fixi5.com).
