Subject: ADA Compliance and Reasonable Accommodation Reminder

As a reminder, all fairgrounds are expected to remain in full compliance with the **Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA)** and all related regulations. Maintaining an environment that is inclusive, respectful, and accommodating to individuals with disabilities is not only a legal obligation, but also a fundamental part of ensuring that our fairgrounds serve the entire community.

Each request for accommodation must be evaluated on its own merits. Fairgrounds should make every effort to provide **reasonable accommodations** that allow individuals with disabilities equal access and full participation in all activities, programs, and services.

Please note that reasonable accommodations are not limited to individuals alone. They should also be extended, when appropriate, to the **children**, **caretakers**, **and immediate party** accompanying the disabled individual at fairgrounds. This practice ensures that our community remains welcoming and compliant with the spirit and requirements of the ADA.

Compliance is essential for the following reasons:

- **Legal Obligation:** ADA requirements apply to all public facilities, including fairgrounds, and non-compliance can result in complaints and legal action.
- **Equal Access:** Ensuring accommodation allows all event attendees, including those with disabilities, to safely and fully participate in events.

We appreciate your cooperation in upholding these standards and reinforcing our shared commitment to accessibility and inclusion.
