Profit Margin Ratio	The profit margin ratio describes a Fair's ability to earn net profit from operations.
Quick Ratio	The quick ratio measures the Fair's ability to meet its short-term obligations with its most liquid assets. Higher the quick ratio, the better the Fair's liquidity position. [(current assets - inventories) / current liabilities]
Quick Ratio (with compensated absences liability)	This version of the quick ratio is more conservative as compensated absence liability is included as a part of current liabilities.
Debt Ratio	The debt ratio measures what portion of a Fair's assets are contributed by debt. (total obligations/total assets)
Equity Ratio	The equity ratio measures what portion of a Fair's assets are contributed by revenues. (total net resources/total assets)
Debt-to-Equity Ratio	The debt-to-equity ratio measures the solvency of Fairs. (total obligations/total net resources)
Net Operating Profit/(Loss)	The Net Operating Profit/(Loss) represents income or loss from operating activities only.
Net Profit/(Loss)	The Net Profit/(Loss) includes all sources of revenues (operating revenues and resources acquired) and all expenditures.
