(b) Quarantine Area. The area under quarantine for Mediterranean fruit fly in California is:

(1) [Reserved]In the counties of Los Angeles and San Bernardino, in the Rancho Cucamonga area: Beginning at the intersection of N Mills Avenue and E Baseline Road; then, northerly along said avenue to its intersection with Cobal Canyon Mountain Way; then, starting northwesterly along said mountain way to its intersection with Cobal Canyon Fire Trail; then, northeasterly along an imaginary line to its intersection with 34.230860 latitude and -117.687499 longitude; then, easterly along an imaginary line to its intersection with 34.230542 latitude and -117.570628 longitude: then, southeasterly along an imaginary line to its intersection with the northwestern most point of Day Creek; then, starting southeasterly along said creek to its intersection with Baseline Road; then, westerly along said road to its intersection with Rochester Avenue; then, southerly along said avenue to its intersection with Foothill Boulevard; then, westerly along said boulevard to its intersection with Mayten Avenue; then, starting southerly along said avenue to its intersection with Milliken Avenue; then, starting southerly along said avenue to its intersection with 6th Street; then, westerly along said street to its intersection with Hermosa Avenue; then, southerly along said avenue to its intersection with 4th Street: then, westerly along said street to its intersection with E 4th Street: then, westerly along said street to its intersection with W 4th Street; then, westerly along said street to its intersection with N San Antonio Avenue; then, northerly along said avenue to its intersection with US Interstate 10; then, westerly along said interstate to its intersection with S Mountain Avenue; then, northerly along said avenue to its intersection with Arrow Highway; then, westerly along said highway to its intersection with N Central Avenue; then, northerly along said avenue to its intersection with San Antonio Wash; then, starting northeasterly along said wash to its intersection with E Baseline Road; then, westerly along said road to the point of beginning.
