

## NPDES Notification Requirements

The California Department of Food and Agriculture intends to conduct a treatment program in compliance with the National Pollution Discharge Elimination System General Permit No. CAG 990007 for Residual Spray Applications, all applicable Best Management Practices will be employed during treatment.

1) Name of pesticide(s) (product name, USEPA Reg. No., active ingredient):

Malathion ULV AG- U.S. EPA Registration #67760-35

2) Purpose of use:

Control beet leafhopper populations on winter/spring host plants on rangeland, hillsides and canyons. Host plants include filaree, pepper grass, *Plantago*, etc.

3) General time period and locations of expected use (attach map if needed)

4) Any water use restrictions or precautions to be followed during treatment:

A ¼ mile (400 meter) aerial treatment buffer will be left untreated adjacent to surface water including aqueducts and canals. Weather forecast will be monitored daily for potential precipitation events. Applications are not performed when a 40% chance of rain or higher is forecast 24 hours prior to planned applications.
