

Coffee root mealybug (*Geococcus coffeae*)

- ❑ Intercepted in shipments from HI; widely distributed in Latin America.
- ❑ Hosts: roots of: Coffee; *Citrus* spp.; *Musa* spp.; *Ficus*; *Dracaena*; Orchids; Fishtail palm (*Caryota mitis*); Lady palm (*Raphis*); Date palms (*Phoenix* spp.); *Chamaedorea* spp.
- ❑ Field ID: Adult female 1.2-2.0 mm long, **elongate oval**; body **white**, **lacking** marginal filaments of wax; with well-developed antennae and legs, and a **pair of prominent anal lobes each terminating in a stout spine**.
