How to Join a Meeting by Phone

To have AT&T Connect call you:
Click the 'Call Me' button below.

To dial in:

- 1 Choose the location nearest to you:
 - Toll-Free (in USA): 888-557-8511
 - Caller Paid (dial to USA): 215-446-3649
- 2 When prompted, enter the access code: **9985092#**
- 3 After you are connected to the meeting, dial **#91019974#** to link your telephone and your computer.

If you are already connected by Phone:

- 1 Dial **#91019974#** to link your telephone to your computer.

Please note that if you do not have AT&T Connect client software installed on your computer, you will be asked to install the software, or given the option of using a web based application. If you choose to download the software, please allow sufficient time (20 – 30 minutes) for the download and software install.



OPTION 2 - *TELEPHONE ONLY* (no computer):
