## (3) APPROVAL OF MINUTES

Board member Helene Dillard moved to approve the minutes of the November 2, 2021 meeting. Board member Andy Thulin seconded the motion and a unanimous vote (11-0) carried the motion. Board members Don Bransford and Eric Holst were not present for the vote.

## (4) DEPARTMENTAL UPDATE

Undersecretary Christine Birdsong provided a brief update to the Board.

The update included recognition of Healthy Soils Week (Dec 6-10) and an overview of activities occurring to promote soil health; CDFA's continued work on implementation of Prop 12 (Animal Welfare) and the ongoing work related to port congestion. Other issues included the USDA announcement on the deregulation of the Light Brown Apple Moth (LBAM) scheduled to begin on December 17<sup>th</sup> – reclassifying LBAM as a non-quarantine pest. Additionally, on December 2<sup>nd</sup>, US FDA announced a proposed rule that would replace the microbial criteria and testing requirements for pre-harvest agricultural water for covered produce. If finalized, the proposed rule would recognize that there is not a one-size fits all solution to water requirements in produce food safety.

The Undersecretary concluded remarks by mentioning that CDFA has created a single portal grants page on CDFA's website to highlight grant programs and funding opportunities. This portal is great resource for agricultural stakeholders to learn of funding availability and timelines. The Undersecretary also provided a brief report on the Secretary's participation at COP26.

The update concluded without formal action by the Board.

## (5) PRESENTATION TO THE BOARD: Natural and Working Lands Climate Smart Strategy

The Board heard a presentation by a representative of the California Natural Resources Agency on the Draft Natural and Working Lands Climate Smart Strategy.
