With more than 58 percent of California experiencing an 'exceptional drought' combined with the negative economic impact of \$2.2 billion to the state's overall agricultural sector, action is desperately needed on a water bond. On behalf of the California State Board of Food and Agriculture, we strongly support your leadership in developing a fiscally responsible water bond that includes significant funding for water storage and the implementation of the California Water Action Plan.

Our current drought situation should not allow legislation to solely focus on short-term solutions, when long-term actions are also needed to improve the reliability of California's water system. Water bonds over the past several decades have not included water storage or the infrastructure necessary to meet our critical needs during times of drought. To address climate change, and the likelihood of more frequent droughts, it is essential that we invest in storage to capture water when it is available for later strategic uses. We applaud your work in bringing stakeholders together to craft legislation for improved local management of this precious resource.
