The California Department of Food and Agriculture supports your participation in Global VetLink eHealth Certificate system. GlobalVetLink provides an online internet application to create Certificates of Veterinary Inspection for livestock and companion animals, and Equine Infectious Anemia certificates with diagnostic laboratory connectivity. The program also allows digital images to be uploaded directly onto the certificates.

GlobalVetLink is accessible through a secure web-based system, so you can create a certificate at any time. Transactions created in your practice will be available real time, and automatically go to all of the appropriate animal health officials.
