California VMB Approved CE Providers

Licensees may obtain CE hours through approved providers. The law (<u>Business and Professions Code</u> <u>Section 4846.5</u>) provides a list of recognized or "statutorily approved entities" that may offer CE to licensed Veterinarians. However, the Board recognizes a **national continuing education approval body**, **the American Association of Veterinary State Boards (AAVSB) Registry of Approved CE (RACE)** to serve as its CE provider credentialing program. ******The Board requests that any provider that is not listed, recognized or affiliated as a statutorily recognized provider above seek approval through RACE.
