

CCA REWARD PROGRAM REMINDER

Since 1994, California Cattlemen's Association has paid rewards for substantial and accurate information leading to the arrest of persons stealing, maiming, or illegally slaughtering cattle in California. The amount of the reward paid by CCA is based upon the severity of the crime, and the program applies to all cattle, including dairy animals. Conviction is not required to receive a reward. Since the inception of the program, rewards paid have averaged \$300.00.
