NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN of proposed modifications to Form 79-015A (Rev. 08/08) "Registration of Transporters of Inedible Materials" and to the originally proposed regulatory text for the Meat, Poultry and Egg Safety (MPES) Branch [formerly Meat and Poultry Inspection Branch; name change effective July 1, 2011].

The documents pertain to the action described in the Informative Digest published in the *California Regulatory Notice Register* on February 18, 2011 [Notice File No. Z2011-0208-14, Register 2011, No. 7-Z] relating to the Rendering Program. The Department is now providing notice of proposed modifications to Form 79-015A (Rev. 08/08) and various sections of Subchapter 2, Chapter 4, Division 2, of Title 3 of the California Code of Regulations. 
