- Speakers While an FSA representative was unavailable to join the 11/12 Sub-Committee meeting, the Sub-Committee maintains its interest in hearing from an FSA officer with expertise on the Non-Insured Assistance Program and other TA services.
- Workflow The SSPAC Sub-Committee will be submitting its draft definition to
 the SSPAC at its upcoming 12/5 meeting. The current SSPAC sub-committee
 members will meet again in December to update the Sub-Committee's
 definition with the SSPAC's feedback and circulate a final version via email.
 At the 12/5 meeting, SSPAC members will be invited to rotate onto the
 committee as it enters its second "recommendations" phase. The purpose of
 this cycling in/out is to honor the effort committed by existing Sub-Committee
 members, and to allow for a diversity of perspectives and expertise in guiding
 the Sub-Committee's ongoing work.
