if you would like to...

procure CA grown or produced, whole or minimally processed food for school meals

AND

engage students in hands-on food education opportunities that complement the school meal program's CA food procurement efforts Farm to School
Technical Assistance (TA) Organization*

Apply to <u>Track 2</u>

if you would like to build capacity* of...

CA School Food Authorities (SFAs) to implement farm to school procurement programs

OR

Educators (employed in CA public school districts, county offices of education, charter schools, or Tribal schools that are an SFA) to implement hands-on food education programs in TK-12 settings

OR

CA food producers to sell products to CA SFAs

building capacity refers to coaching/training/ supporting these entities to implement these farm to school activities themselves Child Care Center in CA OR
Farm to Early Care and
Education (ECE) Technical
Assistance (TA) Organization*

Apply to <u>TRACK 3</u>

if you would like to...

procure CA grown or produced, whole or minimally processed food for meals/snacks and/or food boxes for young children

AND

engage young children in hands-on food education opportunities that complement the meal program's and/or food box program's CA food procurement efforts Food Producer in CA* <u>OR</u>
Public-Serving Aggregation and Distribution
Enterprise*

Apply to TRACK 4

if you would like to...

increase production, processing, and/or distribution capacity to sell CA grown or produced, whole or minimally processed foods to the CA school food market*

AND

if you can show evidence of an established relationship with at least one CA public school district, county office of education, charter school, or Tribal school that is a School Food Authority currently operating the National School Lunch Program OR CA child care center currently participating in the Child & Adult Care Food Program

*NOTE: projects may also, if desired, provide handson food education opportunities for students and/or staff at the above entities to complement California food sales to those entities
