NOTICE OF MODIFICATIONS TO TEXT OF PROPOSED REGULATIONS

Subject Matter of Regulations: Cannabis Appellations Program

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the California Department of Food and Agriculture (Department), pursuant to the requirements of Government Code section 11346.8(c) and section 44 of Title 1 of the California Code of Regulations, proposes to modify the text of the following proposed regulations identified with black font, *italics*, double strikeout and double underline in sections: 8212, 8212.1, 8601, 9100, 9101, 9102, 9104, 9105, 9106, 9107, 9200, 9201, 9202, 9203, 9204, 9300, 9301, and 9302.

The proposed changes are in response to comments received during the rulemaking public comment period that closed on October 19, 2020.

A “Second Addendum to the Initial Statement of Reasons” to provide the rationale for the text as modified and to clarify specified changes to the regulation text has been added to the rulemaking file pursuant to Government Code section 11347.1.

In addition, the documents “Basilico Genovese (Genovese Basil)” and “Vlaams-Brabantse Tafeldruif (Flemish Barabant Table Grapes)” have been added to the rulemaking record as Documents Relied Upon pursuant to Government Code section 11347.1. During the comment period, these documents will be made available for public inspection upon request and accessible at CalCannabis Cultivation Licensing Division during the business hours of 8:00 am to 5:00 pm Monday through Friday.
