## NOTICE OF MODIFICATIONS TO TEXT OF PROPOSED REGULATIONS

**Subject Matter of Regulations: Cannabis Appellations Program** 

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that the California Department of Food and Agriculture (Department), pursuant to the requirements of Government Code section 11346.8(c) and section 44 of Title 1 of the California Code of Regulations, proposes to modify the text of the following proposed regulations identified with double strikeout and double underline in sections: 8212, 8212.1, 8400, 8602, 9000, 9100, 9101, 9102, 9105, 9106, 9107, 9200, 9201, 9202, 9203 and 9301.

The proposed changes are in response to comments received during the rulemaking public comment period that closed on May 6, 2020 and the regulatory hearing on May 6, 2020, as well as changes to Business and Professions Code section 26063 enacted by the passage of Senate Bill 67 (2019-2020 Regular Session).

An "Addendum to the Initial Statement of Reasons" to provide the rationale for the text as modified and to clarify specified changes to the regulation text has been added to the rulemaking file pursuant to Government Code section 11346.8(d), 11346.9(a)(1), and 11347.7.
