Logging In Printing License Certificates Troubleshooting

Note: Cannabis is a Schedule I drug, according to the federal Controlled Substances Act. Cannabis-related activity is subject to federal prosecution, regardless of the protections provided by state law.





#### Logging In

• On the <u>Home</u> page, click on the **Login** link to login to your CalCannabis Cultivation Licensing account.



• Enter your **Username** and **Password** and click **Login** to begin.



 If you're using a public computer, it's important that you <u>do not</u> check the box **Remember me on this computer** because doing so will save your CalCannabis Licensing System username on the public computer.

#### Troubleshooting

- If you're still unable to open the document, click on the name of the license certificate document and select "Save" from the pop-up dialog box to save the file to your computer.

- If you're still experiencing difficulty with opening the document, check the file name. It should have saved as something similar to "Certificate.pdf" or "Certificate.pdf.html". If the file saved as something similar to "Certificate.pdf.html", remove the ".html" from the end of the file name. Then, check the file properties to confirm that it is saved as an Adobe Acrobat Document (.pdf). If not, update the file properties to Adobe Acrobat Document (.pdf).
- Your certificate should open for you to view and print.
