

## Logging In

- On the [Home](#) page, click on the **Login** link to login to your CalCannabis Cultivation Licensing account.




- Enter your **Username** and **Password** and click **Login** to begin.



- If you're using a public computer, it's important that you **do not** check the box **Remember me on this computer** because doing so will save your CalCannabis Licensing System username on the public computer.

## Printing License Certificates

- From the My Dashboard page, click the “My Licenses” toolbar link or the “View My Licenses” button.



- Find the **Active** Cannabis Cultivation License in your “Licenses” list and click on its blue hyperlinked number to open. You can differentiate between record types by looking in the “License Type” column.
