

California Farms by Size, A Comparison...

- The 536 dairy farms producing over 2.4 million pounds per month (37% of the state's dairies) produce 73% of the state's milk marketings.
- In May 2014, 811 dairies produced more than one tanker load of milk per day.
- The 346 dairy farms (24% of the state's dairies) producing less than 750,000 pounds per month produce less than 4% of the state's milk marketings.
- Nearly 42% of the total milk marketings were from dairies who produce over 5 million pounds of milk per month.
- In May 2014, there were 203 dairies producing more than 5 million pounds of milk per month (up from 201 dairies in 2013).

National Dairy Situation & Outlook – USDA Estimates

Latest Data Available:

Monthly: USDA estimates overall milk production across the U.S. increased 1.9% in June 2014, compared to June 2013. USDA reports that California milk production increased 1.7% compared to June 2013. Among other western states, compared to June 2013, Arizona was up 2.1%; New Mexico was up 1.3%; and Washington was up 3.9%. All of the top 10 milk producing states reported a production increase. The largest increase was reported by Colorado at 9.7% growth in milk production.

Quarterly: For the second quarter of 2014 compared to the first quarter of 2014, U.S. milk cow numbers increased to 9.250 million head, milk production per cow increased to 5,700 pounds; the net effect was milk production increased to 52.7 billion pounds. USDA projects that for the third quarter of 2014 compared to the second quarter of 2014, milk cow numbers will increase to 9.275 million head, production per cow will decrease to 5,490 pounds, the net effect would be a decrease in milk production to 50.9 billion pounds.

Milk Prices

Comparing the second quarter of 2014 to the first quarter of 2014, U.S. average all-milk prices decreased to \$24.27/cwt. USDA projects that for the third quarter of 2014, U.S. average all-milk prices will be \$22.80-23.20/cwt.; Class III prices will be \$20.20-20.60/cwt.; and Class IV prices will be \$22.00-\$22.50/cwt.

Utility Cow Prices

Comparing the second quarter of 2014 to the first quarter of 2014, average U.S. utility cow prices were up \$5.96/cwt. to a national average of \$95.08/cwt. USDA projects that utility cow prices will average \$92-\$98/cwt. in the third quarter of 2014.

California Data Summaries

COMMERCIAL PRODUCTION OF ALL MILK

Production of all milk on farms and ranches in California during June 2014 totaled 3.544 billion pounds, 1.7 percent more than the quantity produced during June 2013. For the twelve months ending June 2014, total milk production increased 1.7 percent as compared to the same period the previous year.

MANUFACTURED PRODUCTS

For the month of June 2014, as compared to June 2013, the total manufacture of butter decreased 3.9 percent; manufacture of nonfat dry milk for human consumption increased 11.5 percent; other dry milk products decreased 8.0 percent; manufacture of total cheese increased 2.0 percent, and manufacture of total frozen products decreased 0.8 percent.

SALES OF CLASS 1 MARKET MILK

Total sales of Class 1 market milk products in California during June 2014 decreased 2.4 percent compared to sales during June 2013.


