

OFFICIAL NOTICE FOR THE DAIRY INDUSTRY OF CALIFORNIA

Notice of Determination related to a Petition to Terminate the Quota Implementation Plan

September 20, 2023

On June 22, 2023 the California Department of Food and Agriculture (Department) received a petition to terminate the Quota Implementation Plan (Plan). Per the procedures for handling petitions outlined in section 1103 of the Plan, the Department has performed a review of the petition signatures and their respective reported volume and has determined that the twenty five percent (25%) threshold has been achieved. Therefore, the petition will be referred to the Producer Review Board for review and next steps.

In calculating the qualified signatures, the Department utilized producer data from May 2023 as it was the most current producer information available when the petition was received. A summary of the petitions received from eligible Market Milk producers is as follows:
