



California Cheddar, Monterey, and Mozzarella Production, 1996-2013, In Billion Pounds

- California total cheese production reached 2.3 billion pounds for 2013.
- Cheddar, Monterey, and Mozzarella cheeses accounted for approximately 85 percent of California's total cheese production in 2013.
- Mozzarella cheese represents more than half of all cheese produced in California.



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National Dairy Situation & Outlook – USDA Estimates

Latest Data Available:

Monthly: USDA estimates overall milk production across the U.S. showed no change in December 2013, compared to December 2012. USDA reports that California milk production increased 1.6% compared to December 2012 (on 1,000 more cows and 30 more pounds of milk per cow). Among other western states, compared to December 2012, Arizona was up 1.1%; New Mexico was down 1.8%; and Washington was up 1.0%. Six of the top 10 states reported a production decrease. The largest increase was reported by Utah at 6.7% growth in milk production (on 4,000 more cows and 40 more pounds of milk per cow).

Quarterly: For the fourth quarter of 2013 compared to the third quarter of 2013, U.S. milk cow numbers decreased to 9.205 million head, milk production per cow increased to 5,370 pounds; the net effect was no change in milk production recorded at 49.4 billion pounds. USDA projects that for the first quarter of 2014 compared to the fourth quarter of 2013, milk cow numbers will increase to 9.225 million head, production per cow will increase to 5,525 pounds, the net effect would be increased milk production to 51.0 billion pounds.

Milk Prices

Comparing the fourth quarter of 2013 to the third quarter of 2013, U.S. average all-milk prices increased to \$21.37/cwt. USDA projects that for the first quarter of 2014, U.S. average all-milk prices will be \$22.45-22.85/cwt.; Class III prices will be \$19.55-19.95/cwt.; and Class IV prices will be \$21.50-\$22.00/cwt.

Utility Cow Prices

Comparing the fourth quarter of 2013 to the third quarter of 2013, average U.S. utility cow prices were down \$1.81/cwt. to a national average of \$76.55/cwt. USDA projects that utility cow prices will average \$78-84/cwt. in the first quarter of 2014.

California Data Summaries

COMMERCIAL PRODUCTION OF ALL MILK

Production of all milk on farms and ranches in California during December 2013 totaled 3.47 billion pounds, 1.7 percent more than the quantity produced during December 2012. For the twelve months ending December 2013, total milk production decreased 1.3 percent as compared to the same period the previous year.

MANUFACTURED PRODUCTS

For the month of December 2013, as compared to December 2012, the total manufacture of butter increased 1.2 percent; manufacture of nonfat dry milk for human consumption decreased 28.1 percent; other dry milk products increased 68.3 percent; manufacture of total cheese increased 5.7 percent, and manufacture of total frozen products decreased 27.4 percent.

SALES OF CLASS 1 MARKET MILK

Total sales of Class 1 market milk products in California during December 2013 decreased 2.8 percent compared to sales during December 2012.


