




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
California Production of Dairy Products: Available Supply per Person Fluid Milk, Total Cheese and Total Ice Cream: Comparing 1994, 2003, 2013



Total fluid milk supply available per person has declined over the 19-year period, displaying a 23.1% decrease from 1994, with whole milk supply per person decreasing by 45.4% over the 19-year period. During the 1994-2013 period, reduced fat milk represented about 36% of fluid milk consumption, while lowfat milk and skim milk represented 13% and 14%, respectively.



Total cheese supply available per person has steadily increased, displaying an overall increase of 92%, over the 19-year period.



Total ice cream supply available per person has declined, with an overall decline rate of 12.6%, over the 19-year period.

Note: Available supply per person is calculated as total California production divided by the total California population; this does not take into account finished products produced in California that leave the State, and finished products produced in other states that enter California.

National Dairy Situation & Outlook – USDA Estimates

Latest Data Available:

Monthly: USDA estimates overall milk production across the U.S. increased 1.0% in April 2014, compared to April 2013. USDA reports that California milk production increased 1.5% compared to April 2013. Among other western states, compared to April 2013, Arizona was up 3.2%; New Mexico was down 1.4%; and Washington was up 3.4%. Three of the top 10 states reported a production decrease. The largest increase was reported by Texas at 8.7% growth in milk production.

Quarterly: For the first quarter of 2014 compared to the fourth quarter of 2013, U.S. milk cow numbers increased to 9.215 million head, milk production per cow increased to 5,541 pounds; the net effect was milk production increased to 51.1 billion pounds. USDA projects that for the second quarter of 2014 compared to the first quarter of 2014, milk cow numbers will increase to 9.240 million head, production per cow will increase to 5,720 pounds, the net effect would be increased milk production to 52.9 billion pounds.

Milk Prices

Comparing the first quarter of 2014 to the fourth quarter of 2013, U.S. average all-milk prices increased to \$24.53/cwt. USDA projects that for the second quarter of 2014, U.S. average all-milk prices will be \$24.40-\$24.70/cwt.; Class III prices will be \$22.70-\$23.00/cwt.; and Class IV prices will be \$22.70-\$23.10/cwt.

Utility Cow Prices

Comparing the first quarter of 2014 to the fourth quarter of 2013, average U.S. utility cow prices were up \$12.57/cwt. to a national average of \$89.12/cwt. USDA projects that utility cow prices will average \$96-\$100/cwt. in the second quarter of 2014.

California Data Summaries

COMMERCIAL PRODUCTION OF ALL MILK

Production of all milk on farms and ranches in California during April 2014 totaled 3.671 billion pounds, 1.5 percent more than the quantity produced during April 2013. For the twelve months ending April 2014, total milk production increased 1.4 percent as compared to the same period the previous year.

MANUFACTURED PRODUCTS

For the month of April 2014, as compared to April 2013, the total manufacture of butter increased 1.4 percent; manufacture of nonfat dry milk for human consumption decreased 7.3 percent; other dry milk products increased 16.8 percent; manufacture of total cheese increased 7.6 percent, and manufacture of total frozen products decreased 8.3 percent.

SALES OF CLASS 1 MARKET MILK

Total sales of Class 1 market milk products in California during April 2014 decreased 2.3 percent compared to sales during April 2013.


