E. OLD BUSINESS

- 1. RSA Placing A Device in Service <u>California Code of Regulations Title 4, Section</u> 4085 (a)(1) and Nozzle Repairs. (*Chris Gate*)
 - i. <u>DMS Notice D-01-4</u> Replacement of Hoses or Nozzles on Gasoline Dispensers
 - ii. <u>DMS Notice D-19-02</u> Replacement of Hoses and/or Nozzles on Liquid-Measuring Devices
 - iii. <u>DMS Notice D-19-07</u> Vapor Recovery Nozzle Servicing and Replacement on Liquid-Measuring Devices
 - iv. <u>BPC Section 12500 (b)</u> defines "measuring equipment" as, "...any device, contrivance, apparatus, or instrument used, or designed to be used, for ascertaining measure and includes any tool, appliance, or accessory used or connected therewith." A hose and/or nozzle is an accessory used or connected to a motor fuel dispenser.
 - v. <u>BPC Section 12515 (a)</u> requires persons who have made repairs or adjustments to notify the county sealer within 24 hours. BPC Section 12515 (b) provides one exclusion of notification, for "an adjustment to a weighing or measuring instrument only for the purpose of maintaining it in a zero or balance condition." This further reinforces that the replacement and repairing of hoses and/or nozzles is a "repair" as defined in BPC Section 12531(f).
 - vi. <u>BPC Section 12531 (f)</u> defines "repair," in any of its variant forms, means to provide maintenance, or install, adjust, recondition, or service a device. Replacing a hose and/or nozzle is a repair.
 - vii. <u>BPC Section 12532 (a) and (e)</u> requires a person who engages in business as a service agency to be registered by the Secretary of Food and Agriculture, and no person who repairs a device is required to be registered if the device is placed into service by a sealer or service agency.

F. NEW BUSINESS

- 1. New Bills Introduced:
 - i. <u>SB 314</u> (Padilla, 2025) Weights and measures: electric vehicle supply equipment. An act to amend Sections 12500, 12501.1, and 12509.5 of, and to add Sections 12509.1 and 12509.6 to, the Business and Professions Code, relating to weights and measures.

- 1. "no further testing" for some EVSE
- 2. Developing or identifying existing funding for counties and RSAs
- 3. Tag removed by device owner and for "at least 30 days"
- 4. CDFA-DMS to develop a statewide online system for device registration and methods of payment
- ii. <u>SB 470</u> (Laird, 2025) Bagley-Keene Open Meeting Act: teleconferencing. An act to amend Section 11123.2 of, and to amend and repeal Section 11123.5 of, the Government Code, relating to state government.
 - 1. Repeal "sunset" date making this section permanent.
- iii. <u>SB 533</u> (Richardson, 2025) Electric vehicle charging stations: internet-based applications. An act to amend Section 44268.2 of the Health and Safety Code, relating to transportation electrification.
 - 1. In lieu of existing payment options an EVSE may require the use of an internet application as the only payment method and that it also be required to be used to gain access to the premises.
- 2. Consider Moving RSA Fee Schedule from <u>BPC Section 12535</u> to the <u>California</u> <u>Code of Regulations Title 4, Division 9, Chapter 4</u>
 - i. <u>BPC Section 12537</u>, 60% fees to counties, but not specifically for RSA enforcement
- 3. Placed in Service Reports
 - i. Contents of each report in <u>CCR Section 4085</u>

- ii. Access to each county's report
- iii. Statewide reporting system and <u>CDFA-DMS Template Form</u>
- 4. Responsibility of a service agent when they find a device that is being used out of tolerance or a non-commercial device that is being used commercially *(Lucian Stacy)*
 - i. <u>BPC Section 12532 (i)</u> when a service agent finds a device altered to facilitate fraud they shall report it to the county sealer within 24 hours.
 - ii. <u>BPC Section 12509</u> and <u>BPC Section 12511.1</u> once repaired and corrected, a service agent may authorize the device to be used pending inspection and testing by a sealer.
 - iii. Retiring a Device When an RSA finds that a device is not correct, cannot be made correct, and still has a valid county seal. What do they do?
