F. NEW BUSINESS

- 1. "Factory Audit" Pathway (EVSE) – (*Lucian Stacy, DMS*)
 - i. [SB 969](#) was amended to include requirements for EVSE In-factory RSA testing and certification.
 - ii. DMS Notice [D-25-01](#) EVFS Factory RSA Guidance (January 17, 2025)

- iii. Define the boundary between “Maintenance” and “Repair.” (BPC Section [12531 \(f\)](#)) and SB 969 proposes a version of this for only EVSE.
- iv. Ensure RSAs retain authority over field maintenance despite factory self-certification. The DMS Notice supports this but SB 969 does not.
