SUBJECT: Training Webinars – Weighmaster Law Changes

Assembly Bill 2312 – Weighmasters: junk dealers and recyclers will become effective January 1, 2015. This bill adds a new requirement to weighmasters who are junk dealers and recyclers in addition to the weighmaster requirements that went into effect in 2014 pursuant to Senate Bill 485.

The Division of Measurement Standards, along with Robert Ditto, Central Valley Regional Water Quality Control Board, will present two webinars to train county officials on the licensing requirements and inspection procedures.

During each webinar, the following subject areas will be covered:

- Business and Professions Code 12703.1: background, overview and industry impact
- Definitions from Division 8, Chapter 9, Article 3 of the Business and Professions Code: junk dealer, recycler, and non-ferrous materials
- Metal theft alert system
- New application requirements
- New inspection procedures
- Stormwater Permit requirements- with Robert Ditto
- Revised Weighmaster Inspection Report Form
