SUBJECT: Training Webinar - Junk Dealer and Recycler (JDR) Inspections

Weighmasters who are JDRs have additional licensing requirements and must undergo a mandatory weighmaster license inspection to verify the accuracy of information on the license. Division of Measurement Standards (DMS) staff, along with a representative of the State Water Resources Control Board (SWRCB), will present a Microsoft Teams webinar to train county officials on the licensing requirements and inspection procedures.
