SUBJECT: Training – Package Inspection Basics

The Division of Measurement Standards, with the assistance of Ventura County, will provide training on Package Inspection. This hands-on training gives attendees an opportunity to apply the principles of National Standards and Technology Handbook 133: *Checking the Net Contents of Packaged Goods*, and to fill out Package Inspection Reports (PIRs). Various types of products will be available for testing, including wax coated cheese, aerosols, and ice glazed seafood.

Purpose:

This 2-day class provides weights and measures officials with an overview of NIST Handbook 133, an opportunity to develop skills in testing various commodities, and experience in filling out Package Inspection Forms. No prior experience is required.

Learning Objectives:

- FAMILIARIZE themselves with the layout of Handbook 133 and sampling plans.
- REVIEW the basic testing requirements for various commodities put up by weight.
- EXPERIENCE testing various commodities.
- LEARN how to fill out the package inspection report and determine lot compliance.
