Application: For use in weight monitoring establishments when interfaced with a compatible, certified weighing device and is designed to monitor client dietary information. The system may issue receipts with monetary and client weight information.

Identification: The required information, (manufacture's logo, model name, and version number) may be viewed by clicking on the Help button on the lower right of the main screen.

Sealing: The system requires no provisions for sealing and is protected by a password that is retained by the manufacturer. Provisions for sealing metrological parameters are provided by the certified and compatible scale.

Operation: The operator enters or scans the client information from the UPC member book. Customer stands on the scale (interfaced to the system) and the system may display member information (e.g. weight, member plan, etc.). The system, if requested, may recall member's last stored weight value and compute the difference from stored weight. A printed receipt for non-weighed items and a member "weight sticker" is available upon request. The operator and customer may preview the receipt before it is printed. The system is capable of accepting pricing information for both customer weight and non-weighed items by selecting the PLU item on screen.

Test Conditions: The Model CHAMP for Weight Watchers International Version 3 was submitted for evaluation at the Weight Watchers Center in Sunnyvale, CA. The PC is loaded with a hand-held PSC scanning system using a Tanita Model Number WB-110A weighing element (Certificate of Conformance Number 03-091). The emphasis of the evaluation was on interaction of the software with the scale, the operation and features of the cash register, and receipt issued by the receipt printer and label. The system was tested with loads at near zero and near capacity. The system was also tested with the scale behind zero and in overload condition. Several series of keyboard entries of weighed and non-weighed transactions were performed and several tickets were printed to verify POS receipt print format using a Model Dymo 330 label printer.
