Task#	Task Statement
1	Operate gas powered mowers and trimmers in order to trim bushes and trees, and maintain upkeep of the fairgrounds; responsible for the maintenance and cleaning of equipment.
2	Maintain flowerbeds through the removal of old plants; prepare the flowerbeds for planting; and plant replacement flowers and shrubs.
3	Responsible for mowing, edging, and watering the lawns of the grounds in order to maintain upkeep of landscape.
4	Assist the Maintenance Workers with the preparation and set-up of facilities for events.
5	Clean the facilities and buildings in order to prepare and set-up for events.
6	Set up tables and chairs and place bar sections in order to prepare and set-up for events.
7	Following the event, responsible for cleaning the facilities and ensure the equipment is stored away.
8	Act as crew leader for Alternative Work Program participant, probationers, welfare recipients, and other unskilled workers in keeping facilities, restrooms, buildings, and equipment clean and orderly.
9	Perform janitorial work such as sweeping, cleaning, mopping, emptying trash cans, stocking supplies, cleaning picnic tables, benches, restrooms, showers, vehicles, golf carts, tools, and other pack facilities to ensure upkeep of fair facilities and buildings.
10	Maintain cleanliness and orderliness of the maintenance shop and enclosure to ensure upkeep.
11	Assist in the set up and removal of tables, chairs, and other equipment for interim events. Under close supervision, perform janitorial tasks to include sweeping and mopping floors; cleaning toilets, sinks, building floors, walls, and windows during events and the annual Fair.
12	Dig trenches, pick up trash, empty trash cans, wash down bleachers, clean wash racks, use blower and weed eater. Assist with mowing grass, cutting weeds, irrigating, and sweeping sidewalks, streets, and barn areas. Remove hay, shavings, and manure from horse stalls and livestock barns.
13	Assist in keeping equipment clean and orderly; assist in keeping shop and adjacent compound area clean and orderly. Drive small truck and/or tractor within the Fairgrounds as directed. Perform general maintenance tasks as directed.

14	Keeps keys to fairground entrance gates, facility doors, and gates, opens grounds, buildings, and arenas as instructed.
15	Meets with tenants and orients them to buildings, restrooms, kitchens, and other facilities, and discusses rules and hours of occupancy.
16	Assists visitors by answering questions on rules and regulations and facilities.
17	Acts as crew leader for Alternative Work Program participant, probationers, welfare recipients, and other unskilled workers in keeping facilities, restrooms, buildings, and equipment clean and orderly.
18	Assist with set up and tear down of interim events by moving tables, chairs, and other items as instructed by the Senior Maintenance Worker.
19	Cleans stall and barn areas before and after interim events as required.
20	Assists the Maintenance Workers in the maintenance, repair, and cleaning of the Fairgrounds by washing windows, painting, picking up trash and debris, weeding, raking, shoveling, sweeping, and moving irrigation systems using the appropriate hand tools or motorized equipment, including weed eater, asphalt blower, and Fair vehicles.
21	Perform a wide variety of functions necessary in the general maintenance and upkeep of all buildings, grounds, racetrack, livestock barns, horse barns, satellite wagering and grandstand.
22	Assist the maintenance crew in cleaning, servicing, and repairing existing buildings, fences, exhibit booths, stands, bleachers.
23	Assist the maintenance crew in tearing down buildings and getting grounds ready for new construction.
24	Assist the maintenance crew in making forms for pouring cement, wash down cement and blacktop.
25	Assist the Electrician in finding electrical problems, changing fuses, and indicating where electrical outlets are located in buildings and on grounds. Keep records of the work.
26	Assist the Plumber in minor plumbing repairs and installations as it pertains to digging irrigation ditches, installing, and repairing pipes and valves.
27	Assist the Plumber with repairs to toilets, urinals, sinks etc.
28	Assist the maintenance crew in the upkeep of buildings and grounds for rentals prior to and after event throughout the year.
29	Set up tables, chairs and stages in buildings, remove after use and store them in the maintenance yard.
30	Vacuum, sweep, scrub and wax floors, and haul out the garbage.

32	Assist in helping people with questions/directions.
33	Assist the maintenance crew with opening and locking gates to ensure safety.
35	Lead the work of work furlough employees, and other unskilled employees in performing maintenance work, keeping fairground facilities clean.
37	Assist the maintenance crew with mowing the lawns, raking the leaves, and picking up trash.
38	Assist the maintenance crew with fertilizing, watering, and maintaining shrubs, hedges, trees and flowers on the grounds.
