



## State Water Efficiency and Enhancement Program

The State Water Efficiency and Enhancement Program (SWEEP) helps to implement on-farm irrigation systems that reduce energy use resulting in greenhouse gas (GHGs) emission reductions and water savings. The California Department of Food and Agriculture (CDFA) anticipates awarding up to \$16 million directly to agriculture operations for eligible projects. SWEEP is funded through the Greenhouse Gas Reduction Fund referred to as the “California Climate Investments” program and is administered in cooperation with Department of Water Resources and the State Water Resources Control Board.

### Who is eligible to apply?

The project installation must be on a California agricultural operation. For the purpose of this program, an agricultural operation is defined as row, vineyard, field and tree crops, commercial nurseries, nursery stock production, and greenhouse operations.

### When are applications due?

Grant applications are due by Friday, January 8, 2016 by 5:00 pm PST.
