The San Benito County Agricultural Commissioner's Office has an opening for an Agricultural Biologist/Inspector either at the II or the III level. The level II position requires three licenses (Pesticide Regulation, Weight Verification and Pest Prevention & Plant Regulation) The level III position requires five licenses (Pesticide Regulation, Pest Prevention & Plant Regulation, Weight Verification plus any two others) and a federal phytosanitary cooperators certificate.

San Benito County has a staff of nine full time and five seasonal employees. The county's agriculture is a mix of row crop, orchards and grazing. Our office is a consolidated ag and weights and measures office, where the staff is cross trained for all inspection work. We also operate the county's mosquito abatement program. Phytosanitary inspection, PUE and weights & measures are the largest programs.
