- The San Joaquin Valley losses include all of the Cotton and the Orchard & Vineyard categories. It also comprises the majority of the Vegetables, Melons & Nursery as well as the Hay, Grain & Silage categories. Over \$ 45 million of the Rangeland & Livestock losses were in San Joaquin Valley region.
- The other four regions were primarily driven by Rangeland & Livestock losses.
- The Southern region is low due to the relatively small livestock production compared to the other regions.
