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**INSTRUCTIONS FOR COMPLETING THE SEMI-ANNUAL TONNAGE REPORT**

Licensees are required to semi-annually report the tonnage of fertilizers, agricultural minerals, and compost sold/distributed in California, as defined in the California Food and Agricultural Code, Sections 14512, 14522, and 14563. Do not report Packaged Soil Amendments and Auxiliary Soil and Plant Substances.

The tonnage of materials shall be reported by the last licensee selling/distributing to unlicensed purchasers. Failure to submit a tonnage report, by January 31 and July 31, will result in a **delinquent penalty of \$200**, as stated in Section 14623 of the Food and Agricultural Code.

Tonnage Reports (Form 513-033) provide accurate statistical data on sales/distribution of commercial fertilizers, specialty fertilizers, agricultural minerals, and compost in California. Information you submit is not disclosed in any way that would divulge the business practices of any licensee.

The tonnage report requires a breakdown of raw materials for nitrogen, phosphorus, potassium, and agricultural mineral materials. The amounts of the nitrogen, phosphorus, and potassium ingredients in your formula must be determined, and that amount placed in the appropriate category. If you have a material not listed (BLENDS), place that material in the appropriate “All Other Material” category, i.e., “Nitrogen Materials – All Other Material,” “Phosphorus Materials – All Other Material,” “Potassium Materials – All Other Material,” and/or “Secondary/Micronutrients – All Other Material.”

For Non-Farm Use tons, the tons of nitrogen, phosphorous, potassium, and agricultural minerals must be reported.

- B. Report in whole tons only, and **round off** all tons to whole numbers.**
- C. Non-Farm Use Tons: Refers to material used primarily for application to lawns, shrubbery, flowers, trees, or where there is **not** a crop of commercial value. Enter the total tons of the appropriate nutrient and category for dry and liquid.**
- D. Farm-Use Tons: Refers to all commercial fertilizer, including for golf courses, cemeteries, and nurseries. Enter the total tons for each category, i.e., dry bulk, dry packaged, or liquid.**
- E. Zero Reporting: Zero reports are required. If you do not have tonnage to report, check the “no data to report” box on the front page, certify by signing below, and submit the report.**
