

**EXHIBIT: SOS – G
GROWER / GROVE MANAGER**

**PROVISIONS FOR THE INTRASTATE MOVEMENT OF CITRUS FRUIT FROM OR WITHIN
A SWEET ORANGE SCAB (SOS) QUARANTINE AREA**

Establishment agrees to the following:

1. Establishments Under Compliance

SOS-regulated fruit may only be packed at an SOS Program approved packinghouse/processor and transported by a transporter operating under compliance. Establishments shall contact the SOS Program to verify a packinghouse is eligible to receive SOS regulated fruit, or may verify establishments operating under compliance online at: www.cdffa.ca.gov/citrus/pests_diseases/sos/regulation.html

2. Harvesting Equipment

Harvesting equipment (including containers, barrels, bins, etc.) used for harvesting and hauling/transporting SOS-regulated fruit must be free of leaf and stem debris prior to movement from the harvested grove.

3. Green Waste

All green waste, including leaf and stem debris, must be continuously collected and disposed of on-site or by following the SOS Program approved disposal method specified in the Special Instructions of this exhibit.

4. Inspections

The Establishment shall allow SOS Program officials to inspect the premises to ensure compliance with this agreement.

5. Records

The Establishment shall maintain records for a minimum of three years of all SOS host and green waste shipments leaving the premises. Establishment shall make such records available to SOS Program officials immediately upon request.

6. Training

Ensure all employees receive training to be compliant with all specifications of the compliance agreement and this exhibit.

7. Violation

Violation of any terms of the compliance agreement or this exhibit shall result in the immediate suspension of the compliance agreement until an investigation is completed and for a minimum period of two weeks.
