

EXHIBIT: ACP – NS2 NURSERY STOCK TO BE SOLD IN AN HLB QUARANTINE AREA

PROVISIONS FOR THE INTRASTATE MOVEMENT OF REGULATED NURSERY STOCK
FROM AN APHIS APPROVED OR PRE-APPROVED EXCLUSIONARY FACILITY TO A NURSERY IN
A HUANGLONGBING (HLB) STATE INTERIOR QUARANTINE AREA

Establishment agrees to the following:

1. Exclusionary Facility Requirements

Establishment must be operating in compliance with all facility, treatment, certification, inspection, and shipment requirements as outlined in the compliance agreement Exhibit: ACP – NS1 or similar terms as outlined in a pre-quarantine, voluntary agreement if located in ACP Nursery Regional Quarantine Zone 1.

2. Establishments Under Compliance

Establishment shall ensure citrus nursery stock (CNS) is delivered to a nursery in the HLB quarantine operating under the terms of QC1623 compliance agreement Exhibit: HLB – RN1 and/or Exhibit: HLB – RN2.

3. Certification and Labeling

Establishment shall ensure all CNS intended for shipment into the HLB quarantine area is accompanied by one of the following:

- a. CNS must be affixed with a red HLB quarantine tree tag, <u>and</u> a colored treatment tag (in accordance with section 3(c)) with a unique six (6) digit identifying number and date of treatment; or
- b. CNS must be affixed with a colored treatment tag (in accordance with section 3(c)) with required Program-approved text (see below), unique six (6) digit identifying number, and date of treatment.
 - i. Program-approved text:
 - Side 1: "This plant shall not be moved out of the area quarantined for huanglongbing disease.

 - Side 2: "Esta planta no se debe mover fuera de la àrea en cuarentena por la enfermedad de huanglongbing.

- c. The color of the treatment tag indicates the month it was treated with a Program-approved systemic and foliar insecticide. Below are the tag colors indicating which month the CNS was treated:

4. Self-Certifying Certificate

Establishment shall notify the Program at least 48 hours in advance of all shipments of nursery stock under this permit. If all the following requirements are met, the Establishment may ship eligible nursery stock to nurseries in the HLB quarantine area.

- a. Establishment shall self-certify the nursery stock verifying that all stipulations of this compliance agreement exhibit are met.
- b. Self-certified shipments of nursery stock shall be accompanied by a copy of the applicable completed Exhibit QC-C and treatment records.
- c. Treatment records must contain the following information: date, treatment product(s) used, number and type of each plant treated, and red HLB guarantine tag number(s) issued to the treated plant(s), if applicable.

5. CNS Retail Location Limitation

No more than 500 CNS may be onsite at any one time at any retail location in the HLB quarantine operating under Exhibit: HLB – RN1 or Exhibit: HLB – RN2.

6. Records

Establishment shall maintain records of inspections, treatments, invoices, and shipments made, including guarantine tag numbers shipped to each store, under this compliance agreement and make such records available to the Program immediately upon request. The records shall be maintained for a minimum of three years after shipment of applicable CNS.

7. Violation

Violation of any terms of the compliance agreement or this exhibit shall result in the suspension of the compliance agreement until an investigation is completed.
