## NOTICE OF PROPOSED EMERGENCY REGULATORY ACTION

Pursuant to Government Code Section 11346.1(a)(2), and California Code of Regulations, Title 1, Section 48, notice is hereby given that the California Department of Food and Agriculture (Department) proposes to readopt emergency modifications to Title 3, Division 4, Chapter 2, Subchapter 2 of the California Code of Regulations.

This notice is being provided at least five working days prior to the filing of the proposed emergency regulatory action with the Office of Administrative Law (OAL). A copy of the text of the proposed emergency regulations and finding of emergency are enclosed and available for review on the Department's regulations webpage: <u>https://www.cdfa.ca.gov/is/regulations/ffldrs\_regulations.html</u>

After submission of the proposed emergency regulations to OAL, OAL shall allow interested persons five calendar days to submit comments on the proposed emergency regulations as set forth in Government Code Section 11349.6. Comments may be submitted to the OAL Reference Attorney as follows:

Pursuant to California Code of Regulations Title 1, Section 55(d), any person who submits comments concerning emergency regulations to OAL shall simultaneously transmit a complete copy of the comments to the rulemaking agency's contact person for the emergency regulation filing as designated by the rulemaking agency on the Form 400.
